- 2. A small, basic pro level P.A. system that the presenter can run iPod tracks through. The host should have someone on sight that has a working knowledge of sound reinforcement and the use of the provided sound system.
- 3. An adult drum set and junior drum set are required for the demonstration and audience participation portions of the program. These items will be provided and/or coordinated on a case-by-case basis in conjunction with the author's endorsers.
- 4. Two tables (minimum size 6 ft.): Table 1 will provide free audience handouts and promotional materials. Table 2 will serve as the author's book signing table.
- 5. Bottled water.
